Overview

Crabtree Farms is a non-profit urban farm on the outskirts of downtown Chattanooga that celebrated its 25th year in 2023. Looking forward to the next 25 years, the organization underwent a comprehensive strategic planning process.

The planning team, composed of staff and board members, re-evaluated the mission, conducted research, explored data and assessed financial tactics to determine Crabtree Farms' goals for 2024–2027.

Community Land & Food Access

Primary Goals:

To increase access to education, community connection, and nutrient dense food through community gardening and to provide undeserved producers and emerging farmers with land access, market access, and vocational support.

 - Community Land & Food Access Initiatives will decrease food insecurity in the Clifton Hills and surrounding neighborhoods of the 37407 zip code by providing innovative and relevant urban-based farming programs. This includes educational and vocational opportunities, equitable access to land for gardening and farming, facilitating spaces for connection/community building activities and providing residents with affordable and nutritious food.
